The 2017 State Convention was enjoyable and worth attending. The business at hand was approving or rejecting the 66 resolutions, 3 add–on resolutions accompanying the mailed resolutions, and 6 last–minute resolutions presented at the convention. The bulk of the resolutions (all but three) were Congratulatory, and expressed Gratitude and Appreciation.

Resolution 67, Requested the Annual survey to be added to the fraternal web site, www.KOFC.org.

State Deputy Sonny Santa Ines stated it currently was accessible at KOFC.org.

Resolution 68, Requested online Payment of Dues, Assessments, and Charity be added to www.KOFC.org. State Deputy Sonny Santa Ines stated Resolution 68, Request would not be feasible as each council determines their dues amount, and Supreme would have to transfer the dues and other payments to the individual council. It would be too cumbersome.
