SCHOLARSHIP AWARD WINNER

At Presentation School's Eighth Grade Awards Assembly on May 24, GK Bill Nahorn III presented the Council's Scholarship to Saint Mary's High School to Luke Orlando.

Luke's award was based on his excellent and entertaining narrative of his struggle with his fears; bugs, loud noises, and failure, but most of all his fear of change. The requirements of the contest called for writers to tell us about themselves, their experiences at Presentation School, and why they will continue their education at Saint Mary's.
