



CHRISTIAN PARENTING & FAMILY LIFE





On Saturday morning, October 28, the Respect Life Ministry, in association with the Knights of Columbus and the Daughters of Isabella, sponsored a lecture by Fr. With little kids, be firm but gentle. Children begin to take moral responsibility into their own hands around age 7. As the child gets older, put more tasks and responsibilities into their hands. This is also an opportunity for you to evangelize. And lastly, be creative in your prayer life.
